- 2 years experience as a paediatrician

- Participation in academic and teaching programmes and meetings in the respective departments.
- Responsibility for care of patients at designated hospital and units.
- Management of patients under supervision.
- Attendance at ward rounds and/or tutorials.
- Supervision and teaching of undergraduates.
- Provision of after-hours care for emergency services.
- Clerking and keeping of comprehensive records of patients in the hospital file.
- Outreach activities as planned by the Clinical Supervisor.
- All administration related to training as per CMSA and UKZN requirements.

The APFP builds capacity on the African continent by providing in depth paediatric specialisation and subspecialisation training. Training takes place at the UKZN Department of Paediatrics and Child Health affiliated teaching hospitals in Durban. Upon completion graduates will acquire an MMed or MMed Sci degree as well as FCPaed and will be part of a rich and diverse African paediatric network.
